ORDINANCE NO. 87

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUSCOLA, TEXAS ESTABLISHING A "NO PARKING ZONE" ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF EIGHTH STREET BETWEEN GARZA STREET AND SCURRY STREET; DIRECTING THAT SIGNS BE ERECTED TO REFLECT THIS CHANGE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of TUSCOLA has determined that parking vehicles on certain portions of Eighth Street presents a particular danger to the safety and welfare of pedestrians and/or traveling public and deems it necessary and advisable to establish thereon a NO PARKING ZONE under the authority expressed in Texas State Statue 3.51 as described to provide safe conditions; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to citizen input and information developed by the Public Works Department of the City of TUSCOLA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUSCOLA:

Part 1: No person shall park a motor vehicle, as that term is defined in the Texas Transportation Code, Section 501.002(14) in the following area: ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF EIGHTH STREET BETWEEN GARZA AND SCURRY STREET

Part 2: The Mayor shall cause "No Parking" signs to be erected at such locations necessary to make this change in the parking zone applicable to the above referenced portion(s) of EIGTH STREET.

Part 3: The Mayor shall cause appropriate signs to be erected at such locations necessary to make this change related to towing vehicles parked in violation of no parking provisions known to the public.

Part 4: The Mayor and City Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to make necessary changes to all records of the City of Tuscola to reflect this amendment.

Part 5: This Ordinance becomes effective in accordance with the terms and provisions of the City Charter and State law.
