STEVE MOVED, SECOND BY JAKE, TO adopt a resolution authorizing the submission of a Texas Community Development Block Grant program application to the Texas Department of Agriculture for the 2025-2026 Community Development Fund, MOTION CARRIED

GENNY INFORMED COUNCIL THAT AT THE BEGINNING OF MEALS ON WHEELS WE HAD 18 PARTICIPANTS RECEIVING MEALS, NOW WE HAVE 29 PEOPLE RECEIVING MEALS. PATTI MAKES 20 STOPS 3 DAYS PER WEEK TO DELIVER THOSE MEALS AND THE PROGRAM IS DOING A GREAT SERVICE TO SENIORS AND CITIZENS OF TUSCOLA. JAKE MOVED, SECOND BY BRITT TO INCREASE THE CONTRACT FOR MEAL DELIVERY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$270/MONTH, MOTION CARRIED

SEWER TESTING- GENNY ABERCROMBIE INFORMED COUNCIL THAT INSPECATIONS OF SEWER CAPS HAD BEEN COMPLETED ON THE MAJORITY OF HOUSES GOING TO THE MAIN LIFT STATION; CAPS WE REPLACED AND LETTERS WERE SENT TO THOSE THAT NEEDED REPAIR.
